Your classroom liturgy from The Society of Missionary Children

Objects needed: Globe or map to show Kenya, a loaf of bread, a bottle of water, a schoolbook, a medicine bottle, a t-shirt, a bible and a small table.

Entrance Hymn: Kum ba yah, my Lord

Leader: (Points to Kenya on map or globe)
This is Kenya. There are lots of children living there who need our love and help. What gifts do we have for them?



Child 1: We bring them food
(Brings up the loaf of bread and places it on the table)

Leader: Why are we giving them food?

Child 1: The children have to stay in school, far away from home. They have to take care of themselves and they get hungry. Jesus, you fed the five thousand with a few loaves. Take our small gift and help us to feed the poor children of Kenya.
Lord hear us!



Response: Lord graciously hear us!

Child 2: We are bringing them clean water
(Brings up the bottle of water to the table)

Leader: Why do we need to give them clean water?

Child 2: They don't have clean water from the tap like we have. We can help them to get a water pump so they'll always have clean water to drink. Jesus, you changed water into wine, help us to provide clean water.
Lord hear us!



Response: Lord graciously hear us!

Child 3: We are bringing the clothing
(Brings us the t-shirt to the table)



Leader: Why do they need clothing?

Child 3: Their parents are very poor and don't earn enough to buy them new clothes. Jesus, you told us that when we clothe the naked we are doing it for you. Help us to make these children in Kenya feel good about themselves.
Lord hear us!

Response: Lord graciously hear us!

Child 4: We are giving medicine for the sick
(Brings medicine bottle to the table)



Leader: Why are we giving them medicine?

Child 4: Medicine costs a lot of money in Kenya and everyone has to pay for it, even children. They need our help to stay healthy. Jesus, you cured the sick and lame, help us to help others in your name
Lord hear us!

Leader: Lord graciously hear us!

Child 5: We are giving them education
(Brings the schoolbook to the table)



Leader: Why are we giving them education, how does that help the poor?

Child 5: When children go to school they learn skills to help them get out of poverty. Then they can help themselves. Jesus, you came as a great teacher. Help the children of Kenya get a good education.
